





2004 SIGNIFICANT U.S. LANDFALLING HURRICANES

Hurricane Charley made landfall as a category 4 hurricane near Charlotte Harbor, Florida, late in the afternoon on August 13, 2004.

Hurricane Frances made landfall as a category 2 hurricane near Sewall's Point, Florida, 35 miles north of West Palm Beach early on September 5, 2004.



Hurricane Ivan made landfall as a category 3 hurricane near Gulf Shores, Alabama, early on September 16, 2004.

Hurricane Jeanne made landfall as a category 3 hurricane near Port St. Lucie, Florida, on the morning of September 26, 2004. Jeanne made landfall very near the same place that Hurricane Frances made landfall earlier.


Preliminary U.S. damage estimates are over \$42 billion from the four hurricanes. Over 150 people died in the United States alone.
